#### Statement from the Chairman of the Board

Every year, the Library moves incrementally closer to achieving our goal of an expanded new facility to better serve the needs of the citizens of Airdrie. While we await that process to come to fruition, the Board of Trustees wishes to thank both the staff at Airdrie Public Library for their dedication in working with the limited space available, and the public for their patience in awaiting a new facility and for their continued support.

Our Plan of Service continues to be the guiding document that directs the programming and service offerings at the Library. Trustees receive regular reports on progress towards Plan of

Service benchmarks, and in the vast majority of areas we are meeting or exceeding the goals we've set. While in some cases this has meant a change in priorities, Trustees remain confident that the Plan of Service is expressive of the needs of the community, and works towards meeting those needs as fully as possible.

Finally, it's important to recognize that the work that we do, both as a Library and as Trustees, wouldn't be possible without the continued support of stakeholders in Airdrie: members of the community, local businesses, City of Airdrie staff, and Airdrie City Council (to name a few). We know that everyone's resources were limited this past year, and for those that were able to contribute to the Library (whether it was your time, talent, or treasure) we offer our sincere thanks and hope that your support will we continue into 2020 and beyond. It is our goal to make your Airdrie Public Library the best that it can possibly be, and the only way we can achieve that is by working together.

#### Statement from the Library Director

Notable achievements in 2019 included introduction of online chat reference and the addition of new circulating material types. Patrons can now borrow themed backpacks full of books and educational toys for preschoolers, GoPro cameras, and Nintendo DS devices. Also new last year were bookable tours for new library members, and a 'book time with a librarian' service to provide patrons with more in-depth research help.






